



## Preston Reservoir Swimming Club Fees

In summary there are 3 types of fees involved with the swimming club:

1. Swimming Victoria Fee – Annually on July 1
2. Squad Training Fee – Per Term (by end of week 1)
3. Competition Fee – Per event

**1. Swimming Victoria Fee** - this is an annual registration fee charged by the governing body. It covers the cost of insurance for swimmers, coaches and the club. Swimming Victoria, Swimming Australia and Preston Reservoir Swimming Club also use the funds to provide resources to assist clubs in policy development and training as well as provide various programs and support for swimmers, particularly those that qualify for state and national championships.

This fee is applicable for each financial year period that a swimmer is registered with a club.

**Swimmers pay full fee if they join the club between 1 July and 31 March** and a discounted fee if they join the club between 1 April and 30 June. **The full fee will be liable again in July** for the start of each new financial year.

\*Fees paid via Swim Central incur GST and an additional 1.5% transaction fee

**2. Squad Training Fee (per term)** - This fee covers the cost to pay our coaches and to hire the pool lanes for the term. This fee will be liable at the start of each term and parents will be advised of the fee from the Booking Officer.

**Squad Training Term Fees** are required to be paid **IN FULL** by the end of week 1 of the term. Should term fees not be received **IN FULL** by the due date then a **LATE FEE of \$30 PER SWIMMER** will be applied. Any cancellation after the term has commenced will incur **FULL TERM** fees for that session booking as a position has been held for the swimmer.

If by the commencement of week 4 a swimmer has not paid the term fees the swimmer will not be permitted to participate in any further swims or enter any competitions until full term fees and the late fee are paid in full.



**3. Competition Fees** - Competitions are held with swimmers from other clubs and at other venues. Competitions have fees for entering the competition (to cover pool hire and venue staff costs) as well as fees to cover the cost for any of our coaches to attend the event to supervise and mentor our swimmers. These fees will vary depending on the type of competition and its duration. An email will be sent by our Competitions Co-ordinator advising of the available competitions and their fees.

<b>Number of Swimmers in an Event</b>	<b>Coaches Fee</b>
6 or more swimmers	\$10 per competition day
2 to 5 swimmers	\$15 per competition day
1 swimmer	\$30 per competition day
<b>Swimmers that reach State trials</b>	\$30 per competition day
	\$30 + pool entry for each extra training session organised with coaches

Please note that event fees for competitions are a separate and additional payment either paid directly to the club or to the event organisers via Swim Central.

**COMPETITION FEES** are due when the swimmer's entry is lodged with the Head Coach, Competition Co-ordinator or by a due date as directed by the Club. Should a swimmer fail to attend for any reason, the swimmer is still liable to pay swim meet entry fees. The Swimming Club pays for all entries PRIOR to the swim meet on behalf of the entered swimmers in good faith that fees will be reimbursed to the Club from the competing swimmers.
